Code of Conduct for Students

- Every student must carry his/her identity card while being present in the College Premises.
- Every student is expected to maintain the general cleanliness within the classrooms and the campus in general
- Any act which obstructs teaching, learning, administrative activity and other proceedings of the college is strictly prohibited.
- Ragging is strictly prohibited in the college. Strict action will be taken against students if they are found indulged in ragging, harassment, bullying other students etc.
- Playing cards, chewing tobacco, smoking, spitting and loitering are strictly prohibited inside the college campus and shall invite severe punishment/disciplinary action.
- Use of Cell phones is strictly prohibited during class hour.
- During leisure time, students are advised to make the maximum use of the library as much as possible.
- Students should handle the college properties with care. Damage to the furniture or any other materials may lead to penalty or suspension from the college authority.
- Without the permission of the Principal, students are not allowed to circulate any printed materials within the college campus.
- A student should maintain at least 75% attendance in the Lectures of every subject and 100% overall performance. Otherwise, he or she will be excluded from the University Examination.
- Students are required to have a look at the Notice Board regularly and be always updated with the information related to examinations, fees submission, co-curricular activities, extracurricular activities or other institutional activities/programmes being displayed time to time on the notice board.
